3 entry maximum \$50.00

Poetry entries from adult Art/Photography

Artists (up to 3 poems) \$15.00

Poetry Only

Must be framed and wired.

3 entry maximum- \$30.00

High School Artists (Grades 9-12)

2 Entry maximum – Art, Sculpture, Photography or Poetry \$15.00

Student Artists (Grades K-8)

1 Entry maximum- Art, Sculpture, Photography or Poetry \$5.00

Photography Categories

Spotlight-Night, Architecture, Macro, Nature/Landscape, People, Photographic Art, Still Life, Wildlife/Animals

Art Categories

Spotlight: Night, Acrylic, Digital, Drawing, Mixed Media, Oils, Pastels, Watercolor, Sculpture

Entry Preparation and Requirements

- **Artist Biography.** We encourage artists to provide a brief (75-word max) bio with their application. Bios must be received by April 1st.
- All hanging entries must be professionally presented and suitable for hanging, including framed with matting (all photo & poetry), gallery wrapped, Plexiglas, metal, etc.
- Each entry **must** have our identifying label (available on our current website - stcatharts.org - or with the paper application), filled out completely and attached to the back side of the entries.

All work must be ready for hanging, complete with appropriate wire hanging support (i.e. screw eyes with wire, etc.).

Note: A fee of \$10.00 will be imposed to supply wiring materials at drop-off (not for metal). No Tape, String, Clips. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Patron of the Arts Association Guidelines

- Entries are limited to **700 pieces**. Applications will be accepted until April 1, 2023 or until 700 entries are received, whichever comes first.
- In addition to your maximum entries submitted for judging, please consider donating to our **Silent Auction**. Identify any Silent Auction donations on the identifying label.
- Entries may not be removed until the end of the exhibition.
- All entries must be picked up on Sunday April 30th between 3:15 to 4:15. **No exceptions**. We will not be responsible for artwork left behind.
- Due to pastoral guidelines, we cannot accept any entry containing inappropriate or suggestive material. We reserve the right to reject pieces that depict nudity, violence, etc.
- High School and Adult Poetry will be judged separately.
- Student K-8 entries are not judged, but each judge will select one Judges' Choice Award for this age group.
- A "Saint Francis of Assisi" award will be selected by our committee for an Art, Photography, and Poetry entry that best represents his Patron Sainthood, which is Animals and the Environment.
- Silent Auction submissions are not judged.
- Winners will be notified via email as soon as possible after the judging. Winners are asked to supply a jpeg of their piece(s) for our website announcement.

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards and Honorable Mention(s) will be given in each category. Additionally, each judge will assign a Judge's Choice Award.

Sales

- A 25% minimum donation is required on all sales and any commissioned work.
- Artists whose works have sold will receive a check within approximately 45 days.
